Philipsburg, St Maarten

Landside 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM



St Maarten, is less than 40 square miles, is home to 120 different nationalities speaking over 80 languages and is governed by two countries: the Netherlands and France with secluded beaches and stunning cuisine.

Catamaran Sail and Snorkel (2 hours 30 minutes) 9.30 am start.

St. John's, Antigua


Landside 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM

Excursion Option

Amazing Jeep and Catamaran Combo (5 hours) 9.30 am start.

4x4 safari jeep to Morne Lay-by. Sail to Sarrot Banana Plantation, Margot Bay, fishing villages, and famous Pitons. Swim in Caribbean Sea at Anse Mamin.

Basseterre, St Kitts & Nevis

Landside 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM

Greens in every shade spring from the rolling hills of St Kitts.

Excursion Option

Caribbean Scenic Rail & Sail (8.30 am)

See virtually all of St. Kitts on a unique tour that combines a sightseeing train ride and a catamaran sail. Travel in custom railcars on a line built a century ago to carry cane from plantations to sugar factories. Enjoy views of lush fields, mountains, historic estates, and countryside, as well as engaging commentary, choral entertainment, and complimentary drinks. Complete the circle around the island via catamaran, cruising along the scenic southwestern coast.
